As part of the Computational and Applied Mathematics Initiative at the University of Chicago, the Department of Statistics invites applications from exceptionally qualified candidates for faculty positions at the rank of Associate Professor. The University of Chicago has recently established an undergraduate major in Computational and Applied Mathematics as well as a new Ph.D. program in Computational and Applied Mathematics. We seek individuals with a doctoral degree in statistics, applied mathematics, or related disciplines who are several years beyond the Ph.D. and doing advanced research in one or several of these fields.

Successful applicants will be recognized leaders in their field and engage in interdisciplinary collaboration, and have a demonstrated research excellence appropriate to the rank. Applicants will also be responsible for conducting graduate and undergraduate courses in statistics and applied mathematics, and academic advising of graduate students as requested. Appointments may be made jointly with another department at the University.

You may choose to upload a research statement, teaching statement, and up to three relevant research publications, but they are not required.
