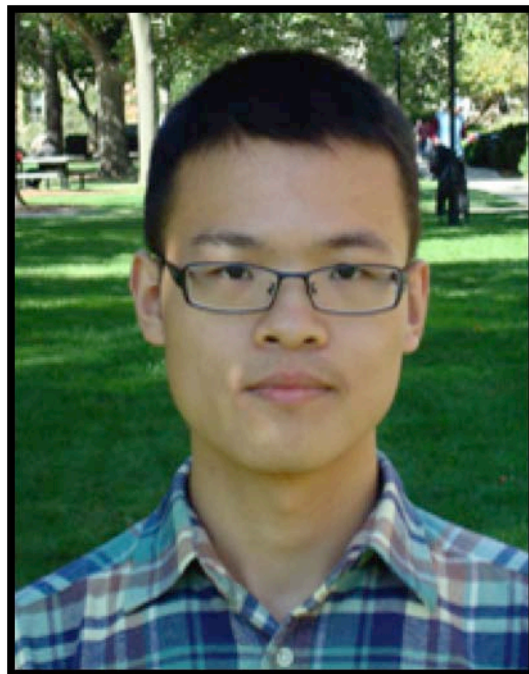


Xiang Zhu Wins ASA Award
